WHAT HAS BEEN DONE?

2ND TRANSNATIONAL PROJECT MEETING IN PORTUGAL

MEETING IN LISBON, PORTUGAL

Members of the FAMILY CIRCLE PROJECT met for the Second Transnational Partner Meeting on 5th – 6th of March 2020.



THE HOSTING PARTNER

The Second Transnational Project Meeting of the Family Circle Project was organized by the Portuguese partner – StoryTellme.

StoryTellme is a company based in Lisbon, Portugal. The main mission of organisation is to create learning environments in which students are challenged rather than directed, stimulate motivation and develop their skills.

StoryTellme develops original concepts, through illustrated stories/comics or storytelling, multimedia production and technical development.

The second project meeting started with a short review of the project – intellectual outputs, objectives, schedule and general development. The meeting was filled with discussions on the resources developed by the FAMILY CIRCLE partnership in previous months.

Firstly, partners analysed and discussed IO1 of the project, comprising of 12 comic books. Then, the partnership presented a draft framework for development of the WebQuests Challenges. Next, partners discussed the framework concerning the Induction workshops/parents workshops and agreed the functionality of the e-learning platform.

Additionally, consortium discussed administration, technical and management issues of the project. The meeting was finished with clear division of tasks among partners and establishing deadlines for coming months.
