In this edition, we talked about what we did, what we are going to do, and we highlight our eLearning platform.

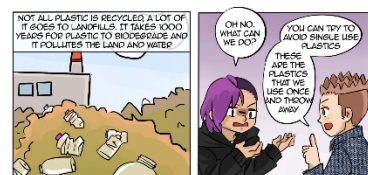
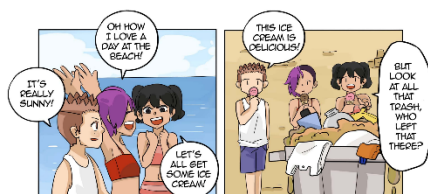
In the Family Circle project's Online Learning Platform, you will find a personalized, fully mobile, collaborative online learning environment that supports access on smartphones and tablets.

## What is the circular economy?
